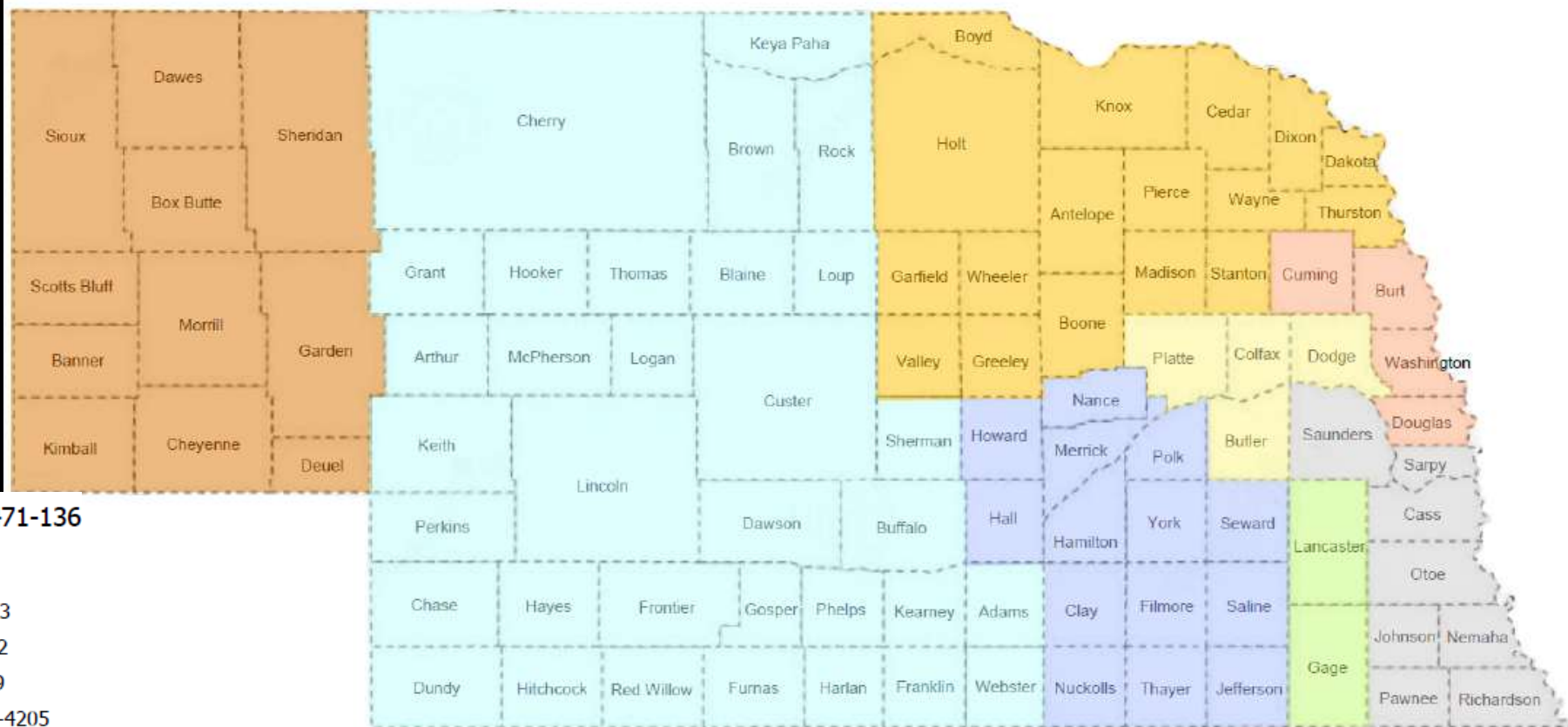
NDEE UPDATE

- NDEE staff changes since July 2024:
 - Interim Director Jesse Bradley (NDEE and NDNR)– Started February 11, 2025
 - Reuel Anderson – Permitting and Engineering Division Administrator
- NDEE conducting 6 MS4 inspections annually
 - 14 inspections since 2022
- NDEE has reassessed permitting priority due to EPA requirements
 - All general permits reviewed within 10 days (CSW, ISW)
 - Livestock priority
 - New individual permits – Industrial and POTWs
 - Major individual permits
 - Individual small permits
 - General permit issuance

MS4 GENERAL PERMITS

- Working with EPA on the implementation of online permit applications as required by the Phase II electronic reporting rule.
 - Current date of implementation – December 31, 2025
 - Main source of delay of permit implementation
- NDEE will send current application information to EPA for these permits.
 - May request new SWMPs to be submitted within 180 days after general permit issuance.
- No new MS4 permittees from 2020 Census
- No new regulations

CONSTRUCTION STORMWATER COMPLIANCE

- A CSW inspection identifies compliance with key areas of a construction site and permit conditions.
 - The Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP)
 - Construction site access
 - Erosion control (BMP's)
 - Perimeter controls
 - Basins and impoundments
 - Unpermitted discharges

CSW COMMON DEFICIENCIES

- Inspections:
 - Onsite inspector not knowing what to look for
 - Lack of documentation/not occurring
 - Mix-and-match schedule
- Failure to obtain authorization
- BMPs not being maintained
 - Installed?
- Track out
- Dust control
- Waste not controlled
- Improper concert washouts

INSPECTION SCHEDULES

- 1) Once every 7 days
- 2) Once every 14 days **and** within 24 hours of the occurrence of a storm event of 0.25 inches or greater, or the occurrence of runoff from snowmelt sufficient to cause a discharge

Reduced Frequency Requirements

- Entire site is stabilized
- Runoff is unlikely due to winter conditions
- Must continue to maintain BMPs
